
Doors open at 7pm for teas and coffees and time to look at displays, information and books for sale.

Luscombe Cross 



The Forthcoming Planning Application for two giant 325ft wind turbines at Luscombe Cross will be made in only a few weeks time. But it is not just a question of one isolated wind farm. This will be only the first of a succession of applications anticipated in the South Hams, which at present has sites identified for 46 turbines.

The issues

Beyond their ugly industrial intrusion on the landscape, wind farms can create serious damage in the nearby natural environment, affecting both livestock and wildlife. They can generate intrusive noise and visual disturbance for local residents, in some cases forcing them out of their homes.

Our speakers will explain how wind energy falls far short of the clean, green and renewable solution to our country's needs, as is claimed. They will unravel the complexities of the process of subsidies, by which developers and investors in these schemes can make handsome profits, which the rest of us have to pay for. They will show how the unreliability of the wind, and the consequent modest amount of electricity generated, demands that close to 100% of existing power station back-up has to be kept at the ready, 24/7.

They will also talk about the driving force behind these developments.....the deeply entrenched belief that the carbon dioxide produced from the burning of fossil fuels is on the brink of causing a runaway and catastrophic overheating of the planet..... hence the rush for renewables, i.e. wind turbines. Our speakers will show that the so-called "greenhouse effect" is a Victorian scientific misconception...but being kept alive by certain vested interests in order to promote their goals.

Guest Speakers

John O'Sullivan LLB has lectured on law and writes and publishes internationally on climate corruption and the greenhouse gas theory. He is coordinator and a co-author of the book "Slaying the Sky Dragon", which challenges the CO2-centred theory of climate change.

Hans Schreuder is a retired analytical chemist, with interests in climate analysis and environmentalism. He is also a co-author of "Slaying the Sky Dragon". Over the last 7 years he has been in communication with many of the world's leading scientists, both climate alarmists and climate realists.
